Tennis Courts

There was a brief discussion re use of tennis courts, SE updated meeting that football coach currently unavailable. Cllr T referred to football coaching taking place at Grange primary school. Cllr W and Cllr T met with Director of Neighbourhood Services re tennis courts and pavilion and it has been remitted to property services to bring this area up to standard. Hope to have details for next meeting.

Seaview House

Cllr T updated the meeting on the proposed capacity for the new Seaview School and confirmed that this was staying the same as the present capacity. She also confirmed that the Seaview House will definitely be sold in order to pay for the school.
